Dear Essendon Families, Sports Day - Go Team Essendon!





Eton Mess



Ingredients

6 meringues or 18 mini-meringues

450g strawberries

2 tbsp caster sugar

570ml double cream

Serves 6

Method

- Wash the strawberries, carefully hull them and cut them into thick slices (small ones can be halved).
 Sprinkle them with the sugar and chill for 2 hours.
- 2. Whip the cream until it forms soft peaks.
- Place the meringues in a plastic food bag and crush them with a rolling pin. (Try to not reduce them to dust – you want a mixture of small pieces and large chunky ones.)
- 4. Gently fold the chilled strawberries and their juices into the cream along with the crushed meringue.
- 5. Spoon the Eton mess into individual bowls and serve.
